Notice is hereby given that on the 20<sup>th</sup> July 2020 Gloucestershire County Council made an Experimental Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be to experimentally prohibit any goods vehicle having or exceeding a maximum gross weight of 7.5 tonnes to proceed along that length of road as shown in the Schedule below with exemptions.

The road falls within the boundaries of the Parishes of Oddington and Adlestrop both of which are within the Cotswold District of the County of Gloucestershire.
